

Temporary & Political Signs (Restricted Areas Map)

- City Maintained Property/ROW
- UDOT Gateway Right of Way
- City Owned Road

No sign shall be located on public property or within any right-of-way.

Generally, the City's right-of-way begins at the back of sidewalk and any sign in the right-of-way will be removed.

Within the UDOT (Gateway) right-of-way signs must be placed behind the back of sidewalk.

No sign shall be located on public property or within any right-of-way unless otherwise permitted in Chapter 19.18 of the City of Saratoga Springs Land Development Code. No sign shall extend over a public right-of-way, except awning or canopy signs, and projecting or suspended signs. In cases where a sign hangs over a public right-of-way, it shall extend no more than five (5) feet over a public sidewalk as measured from the face of the supporting building. All signs that hang over the public right-of-way shall have a minimum clearance of eight (8) feet from the ground. Subject to any and all other restrictions in Chapter 19.18 of the Land Development Code consistent therewith, noncommercial temporary signs are allowed within the park strip area of a residential right-of-way during an election period, civic event or other special event as determined by the City. Approval of the property owner(s) is required.
