

American Fork / Pleasant Grove Lehi Soccer/Saratoga Springs

7-9 Grade - Tournament rules

**All players must be legally registered on your team.
Rosters may be checked before, during or after a game.**

All league and High school rules will also apply to the tournament with the exception or inclusion of the following:

- **ARRIVE EARLY** - Game time is the posted time on the schedule and may begin if referees and field are ready. Each team must have a minimum of 6 players to begin play without being considered a forfeit. A forfeit will be declared if a team has fewer than 8 players, when the referees whistles, at the end of the **FIRST** half.
- If both teams are unable to field 8 players at the end of the first half, the team with the most players at that time will be considered the winner. **Opposing team is not required to play down to the # of players the other team has, they can choose to play with **11**.

Games will consist of two - 30 minute halves with a 4 minute half time. "Official game time and score will be kept on the field by the officials"

- Players may not play with anything officials deem to be dangerous to themselves or others. This includes watches, hats, casts, illegal shoes or illegal cleats (no toe cleats allowed).
- Coaches, Assistants and players are asked to limit their walking and coaching to only their half of the sideline to the top of the penalty box. Coaches/teams may choose opposite sides of the field to occupy.
- Games that end in a "Tie" at the end of regulation play:
 - If game is tied at the end of regulation play, a shoot out will take place 12 yards from the goal line. Each team chooses 5 players from their team to kick from the 12 yard mark. Players must be chosen from those players in the game when time expired. Teams will alternate taking penalty kicks. Goal keepers may be substituted between kickers and may also be used as one of the kickers.
 - In case of a tie after the first round of penalty kicks, a sudden death shootout would follow. Players are only allowed to participate as a shooter once in the shootout until all 11 players have shot.
- In case of inclement weather/lightening, games can be postponed for 30 minutes. After a postponement, if games cannot be resumed, a game will be considered complete if ½ of the game has been played. A game not ½ complete when postponed or canceled, will be rescheduled and begin again at the point of cancelation.
