POLICE BLOTTER INFORMATION- June 2011

STATISTICAL DATA FOR JUNE 2011:

The Bluffdale City Police Department has handled a total of **962** offenses, to date.

The Department handled: **187** reported incidents for the month.

The Department handled: **18** reported traffic accidents during the month.

The Investigations Division has been working **167 Active** cases during the month of: **June 2011**.

CASE SAMPLING FOR JUNE 2011:

RECOVERED STOLEN CAR

A Bluffdale Police Officer was on routine patrol when he noticed a car parked in a church parking lot in the early morning hours. The officer checked the car's license plate and found it had been reported stolen out of North Dakota. Officers found a man asleep in the back of the car. The man told officers the car technically was his, but his ex-girlfriend must have reported it stolen. The suspect was booked into the Salt Lake County Jail.

CAR BURGLARY

Officers were dispatched to the Country Living Subdivision on a report of a vehicle burglary. The victim told officers someone entered her car during the night and took an iPod and \$20 cash from her car. The victim thought her car was locked, but there were no signs of forced entry into the car. There currently is no suspect information.

GARAGE BURGLARY

A Spring View Farms resident reported some items were missing from her garage. The resident reported her garage was left open over night and someone took two mountain bikes and two golf bags with clubs. The detective division is currently investigating the case.

ROCK THROWING

B.D.P.D. Officers were dispatched to the Boulder Ridge Subdivision. A motorist reported she was driving on 3200 West, when two juvenile males threw a rock at her car damaging it. The motorist was able to point out where the juveniles were hiding out in a field. The officer located the two juveniles trying to crawl away in the field. The juvenile's parents were contacted and they were referred to Juvenile Court for criminal mischief.

DUI CRASH

Two separate witnesses reported a car was driving recklessly through the city. While the witnesses were on the phone with dispatch, the car crashed into a cinderblock wall. Officers arrived on scene and found the driver was under the influence of drugs. Officers located drug paraphernalia inside of the car. The driver was arrested and booked into jail on several charges.

COPPER WIRE THEFT

A Bluffdale resident in the River Willows Estates Subdivision reported a theft from his work truck. The victim reported his work truck was parked in his driveway over night. When the victim went out to his truck in the morning, he found someone had cut 300 feet of copper welding wire from a welder on his truck. There currently is no suspect information. Investigators are working the case.

DOMESTIC & DUI

Officers were dispatched to a residence on a report of a domestic situation. A woman reported her ex-boyfriend barged into her home, assaulted her and took their 15 year old son. The boyfriend got into his truck and drove away. Officers checked the area and were able to locate the boyfriend. Officers found the boyfriend was intoxicated while driving. The boyfriend was arrested for enhanced DUI (driving with a child in the car) and domestic violence assault. The boyfriend was booked into jail.

DON'T CHASE CARS

B.D.P.D. Officers were dispatched to the Turner Estates subdivision on a report of a male yelling and chasing after cars. Officers responded to the area and located the male. The male stated he had been yelling at speeding cars. Officers noticed the male appeared to be very intoxicated and could barely stand up. The suspect's mother approached officers and told officers she felt the suspect was out of control and she no longer wanted him at her home. The suspect was arrested and booked into jail on various charges.
