POLICE BLOTTER INFORMATION-

STATISTICAL DATA FOR SEPTEMBER 2011

The Bluffdale City Police Department has handled a total of 179 incidents in Sept.
The Department handled: 19 reported traffic accidents during the month.
The Investigations Division has been working 115 **Active** cases during the month of: Sept.

CASE SAMPLING FOR SEPTEMBER 2011:

BURGLARY

Bluffdale Officer responded to a storage facility to investigate multiple house trailer burglaries. The individual(s) responsible for the burglaries gained access into the trailers by breaking the glass windows on the side doors to unlock the locking mechanism. It is undetermined, at this time, if any items were taken from the trailers. Further investigation will reveal the actual loss of property, if any. The surveillance video from the storage facility was reviewed by the Bluffdale Officer; however, these particular trailers were not being monitored by the camera equipment. The Bluffdale Officer photographed all of the camp trailers and he detected a cross pattern of a glove print on all of trailers, but no fingerprints. This case is currently under investigation by the Bluffdale Detectives.

BURGLARY/THEFT OF COMPUTER EQUIPMENT

Bluffdale Officer responded to an in-patient treatment center to investigate a break-in and theft of computer equipment. The Officer learned that the Suspect broke a basement window to access the office area, where three expensive computers were stolen. The owner of the stolen computers believes the person responsible was most

likely a former resident of the treatment center. The Officer entered all of the stolen computers on the National Crime Database, as stolen. This case is currently under investigation by the Bluffdale Detectives.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

Bluffdale Officer responded to a physical altercation between a boyfriend and girlfriend. The boyfriend found an unfamiliar telephone number in the call history of his girlfriend's mobile phone. An argument began and the boyfriend grabbed his girlfriend by the hair and threw her cell phone against the ground, where it shattered. The boyfriend left the residence before the Officer could arrive. Formal domestic violence charges were filed against the boyfriend with the Bluffdale Prosecuting Attorney.

TRAFFIC OFFENSE

Bluffdale Officer received information from a concerned citizen that an individual was operating a four wheeler at a high rate of speed on Camp Williams Road. A second person was also terrified of the irresponsible behavior that the driver was exhibiting. The Officer located the all terrain vehicle and driver. There were several other violations observed by the Officer. The adult operator was issued a citation for various traffic offenses and the vehicle was impounded.

DUI

Bluffdale Officer was assisting another Officer, when he detected an odor of alcohol beverage coming from the driver. The Officer conducted four field sobriety tests. It was determined by the Officer that the driver was impaired to the degree to render him incapable of operating a motor vehicle safely. The driver was arrested for driving a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol. The driver was issued DUI citation and released to a responsible person.
