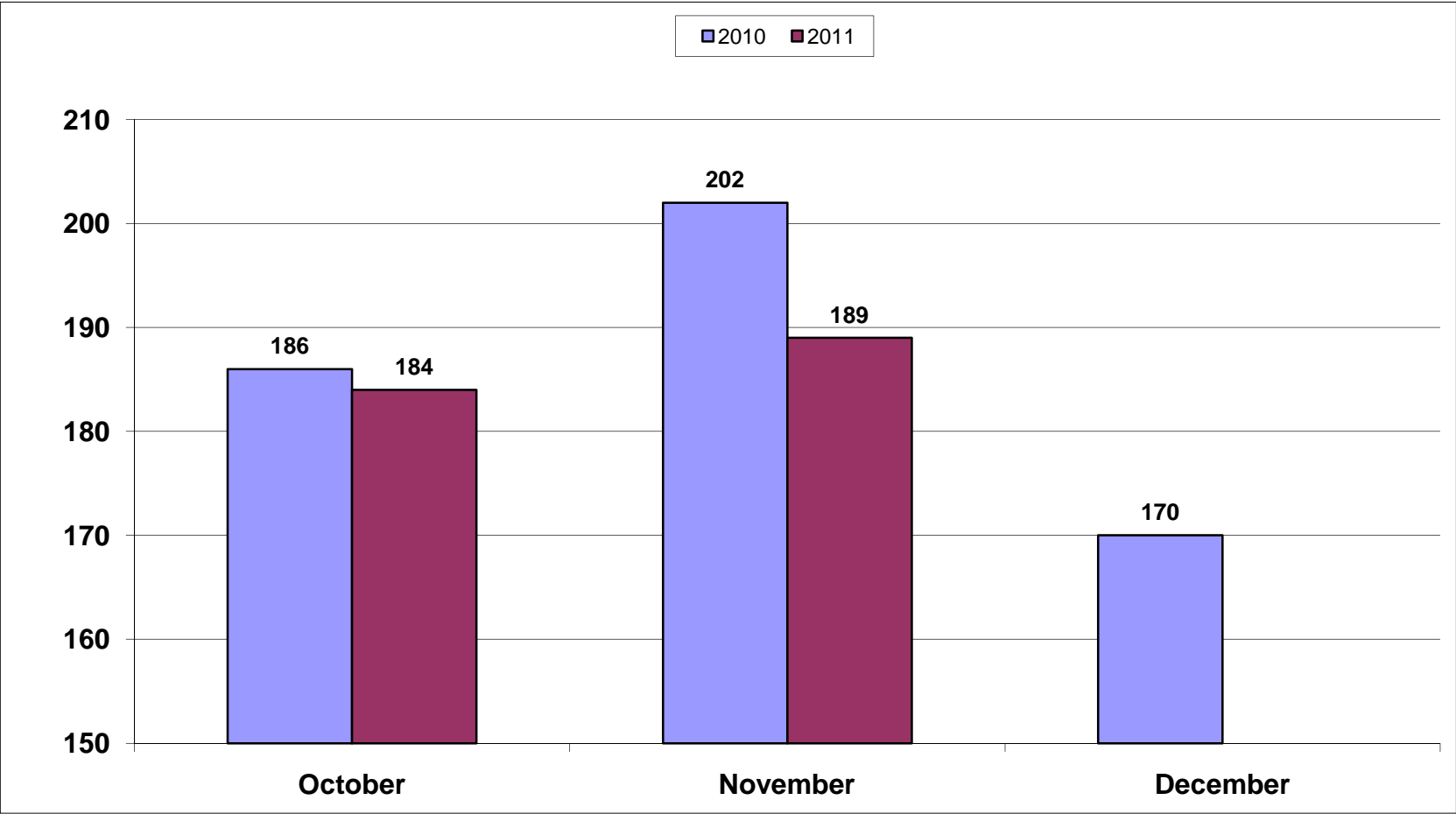
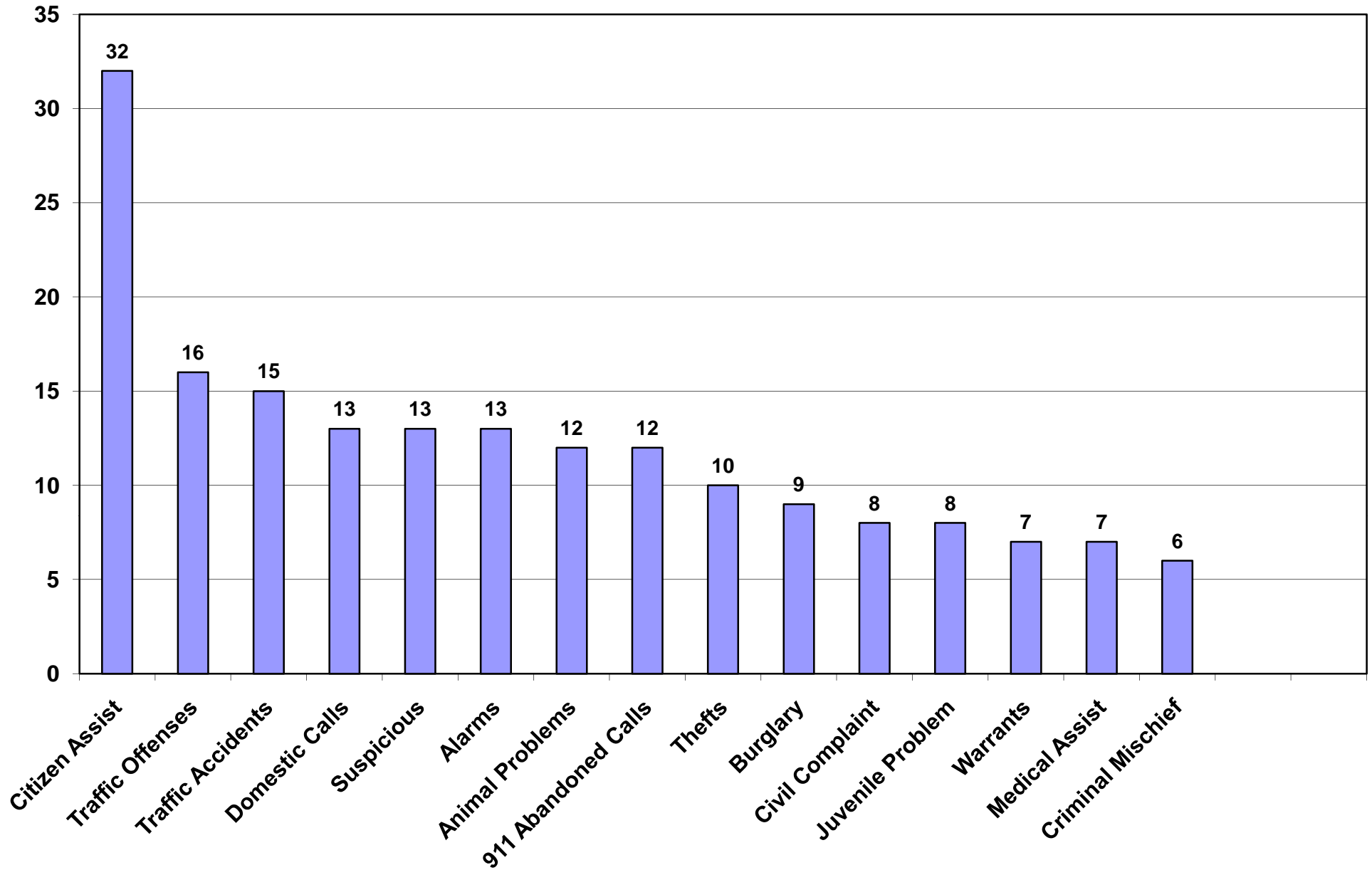


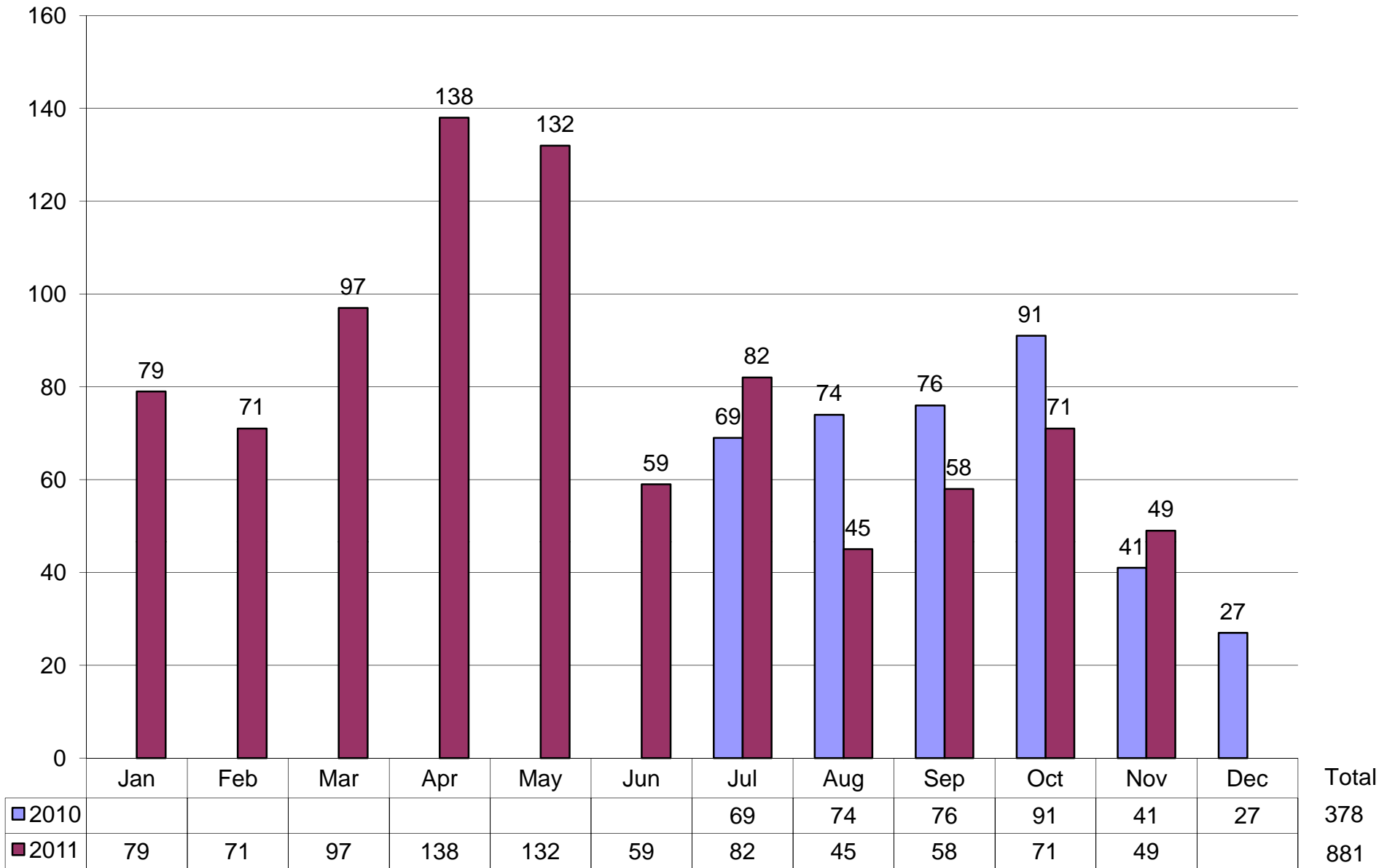
# Bluffdale Police Department 4th Quarter Stats - Total Incidents



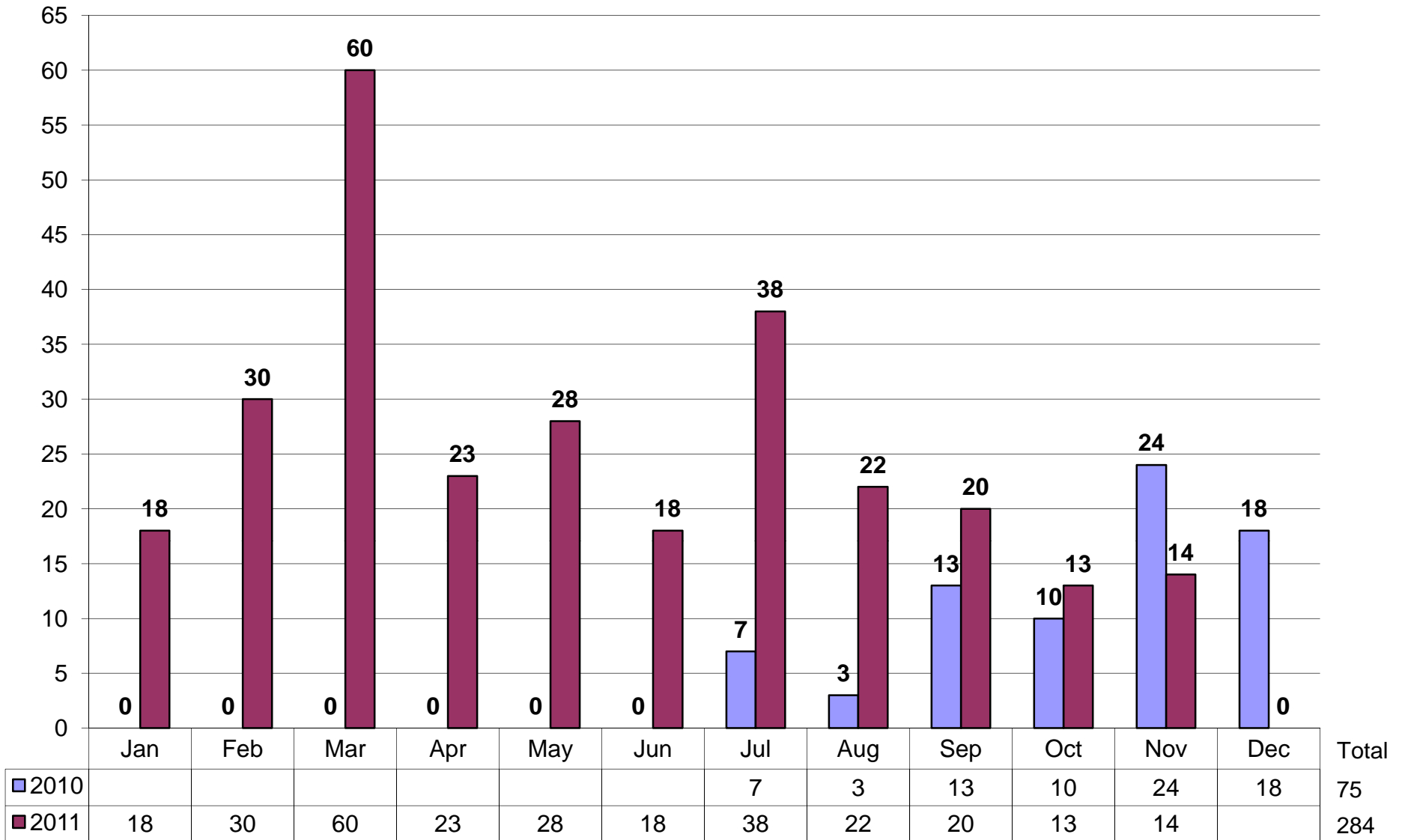

**BLUFFDALE INVESTIGATIONS DIVISION MONTHLY SUMMARY  
November 1-30<sup>th</sup>, 2011**

Among the cases involving the Investigations Unit were 7 burglaries, 0 vehicle burglaries, 15 cases involving thefts and frauds, 15 cases involving domestic violence and family problems, 0 vehicle theft, 1 sex offense, 2 drug case, 1 mental subject, 4 weapons offenses, 2 child abuses, 2 criminal mischief cases, 2 missing persons, and 6 threatening and harassment cases. .

Investigations are continuing to follow up on 87 active cases. Also, 1 arrest warrant was authored and issued, 13 cases were cleared by arrest (including juveniles), and 12 cases are currently being screened with the District Attorney and the City Attorney. November was a particularly busy month for thefts, burglaries, and domestic problems.

In addition to this, a serious sex offense case was investigated and filed with the District Attorney’s Office. This case involves a juvenile female and an adult male. So far there have been 58 felony charges requested on this case, which is still under investigation.

Also, we coordinated efforts with another agency when common information was found dealing with a fraud/identity theft. Arrests were made and restitution requested for a local citizens loss. The arrests lead to information on a large identity theft/fraud ring which was selling items to a Russian black market. This was a significant find which helped shut down a large ring of suspects state wide and solved many cases.

**CITIZENS ASSISTING POLICE**

Citizens Assisting Police were not able to patrol this month due to the CAPS car being gone for repairs for a short time, and vacation and holiday plans. CAPS patrol hours will improve this next month.
