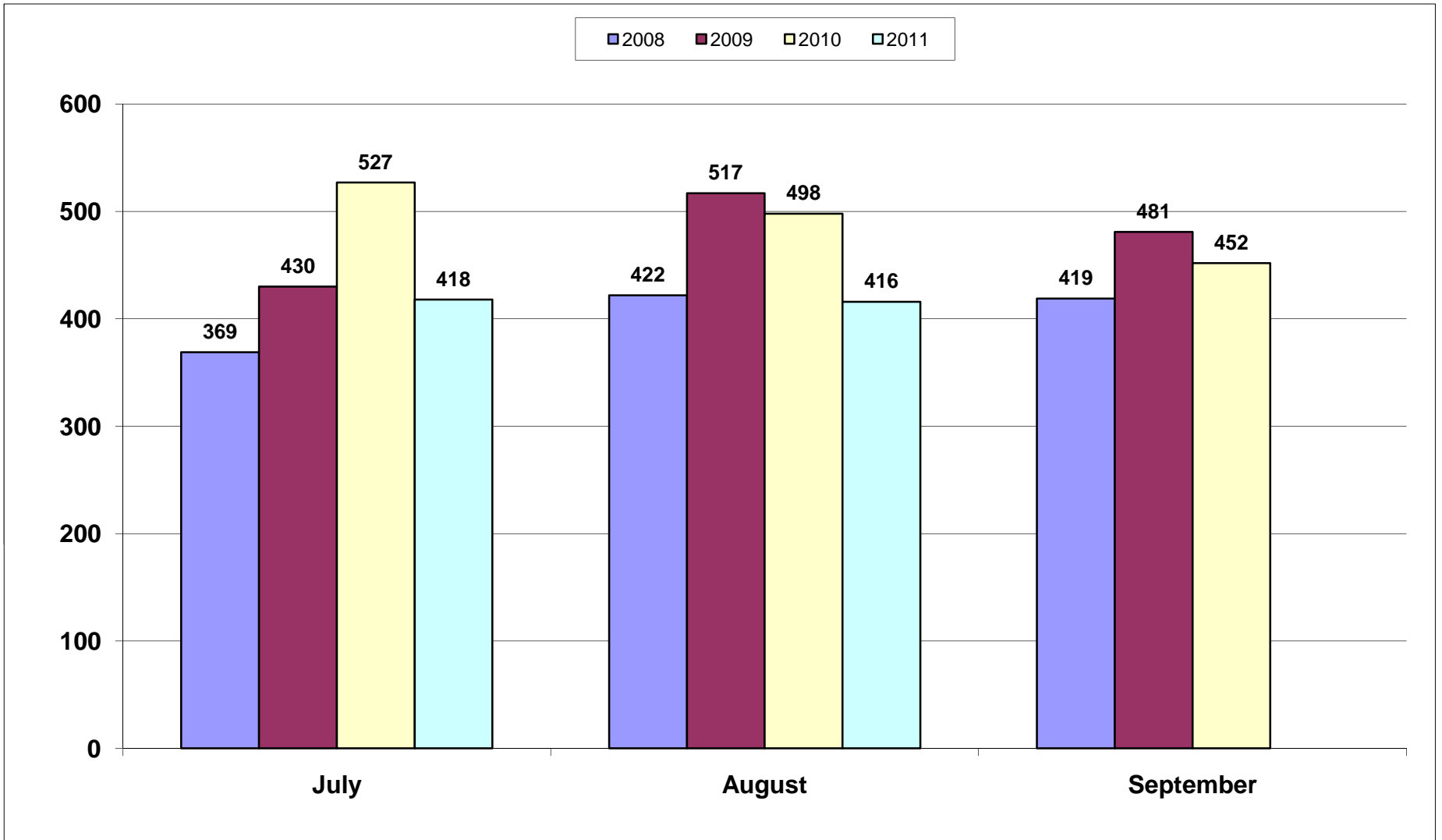
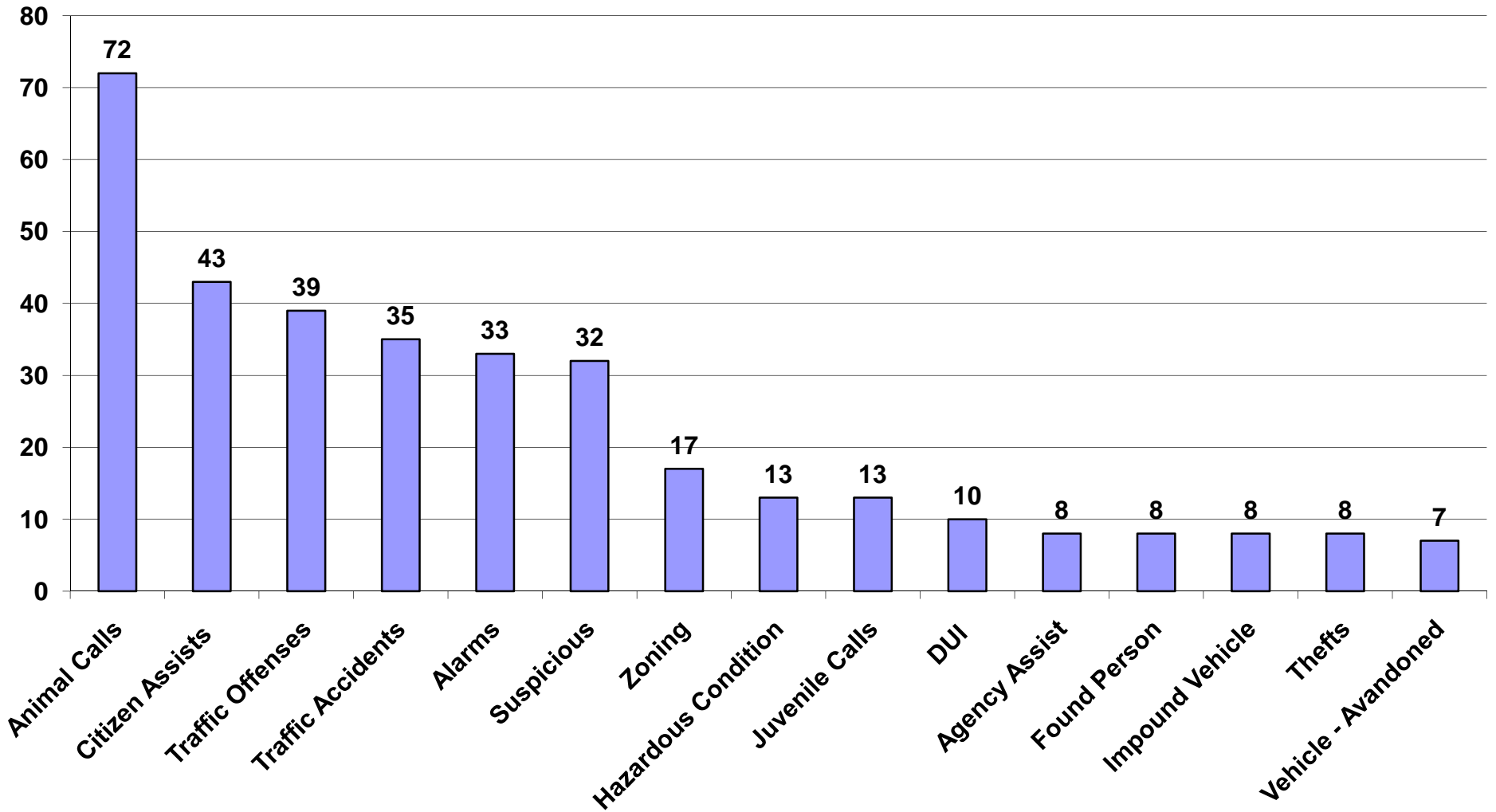


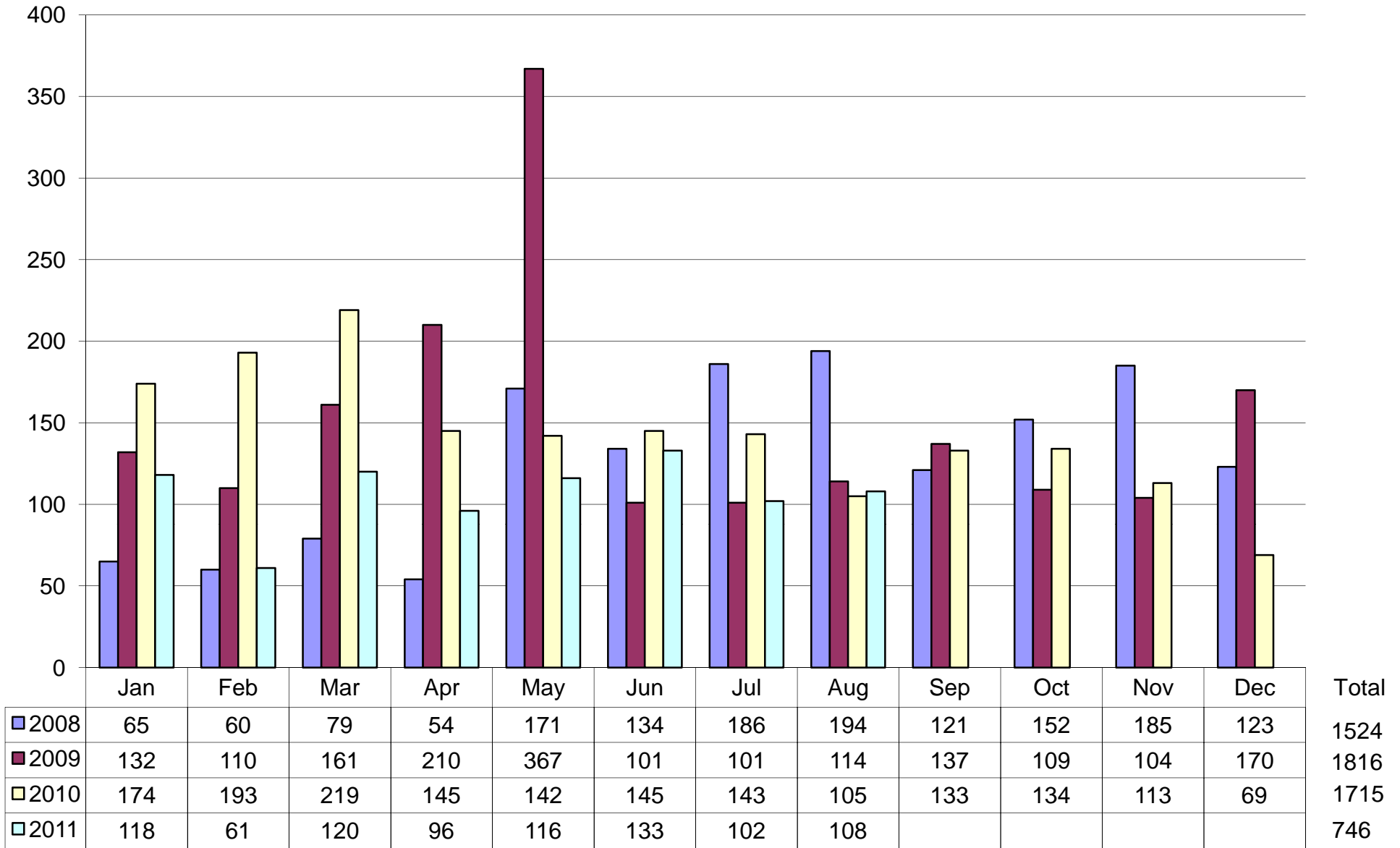
Saratoga Springs Police Department 3rd Quarter Stats - Total Incidents



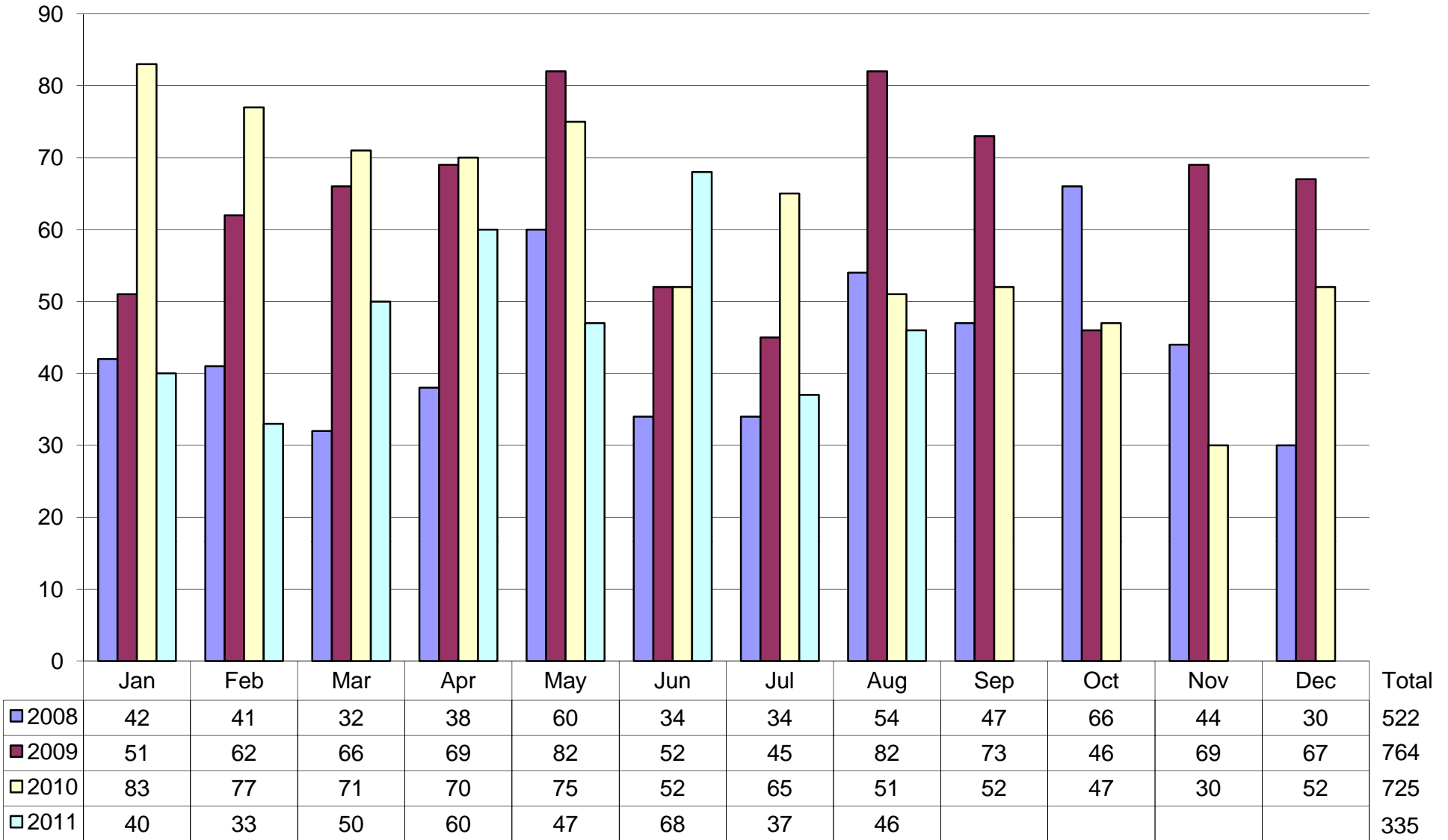
Saratoga Springs Police Department Stats for August 2011

INVESTIGATIONS DIVISION MONTHLY SUMMARY

August 1-31, 2011

New, significant, and labor intensive cases received by the Investigations Unit included sex offenses, domestic violence, child abuse, assaults, drug activity, gang activity, and ten new investigations involving thefts, identity thefts, frauds, or burglaries in addition to follow-up on existing active cases, which remained consistent with the caseload experienced the previous month. Multiple sex offender registrations were completed at the police department, and gang members contacted and intelligence gathered.

The Investigations Unit conducted the radKIDS Community Steering Committee coordinating the delivery of the program in the elementary schools for the new school year. The Forensic Dive Team assisted with the recovery of a submerged vehicle at the Pelican Bay Boat Harbor. The Westlake High School Resource Officer (SRO) received a school employee of the month award and multiple reports of damage to homes were cleared with the arrest of the responsible juveniles.

Detectives received training on specialized interviewing and the Image Scan forensic computer program.
