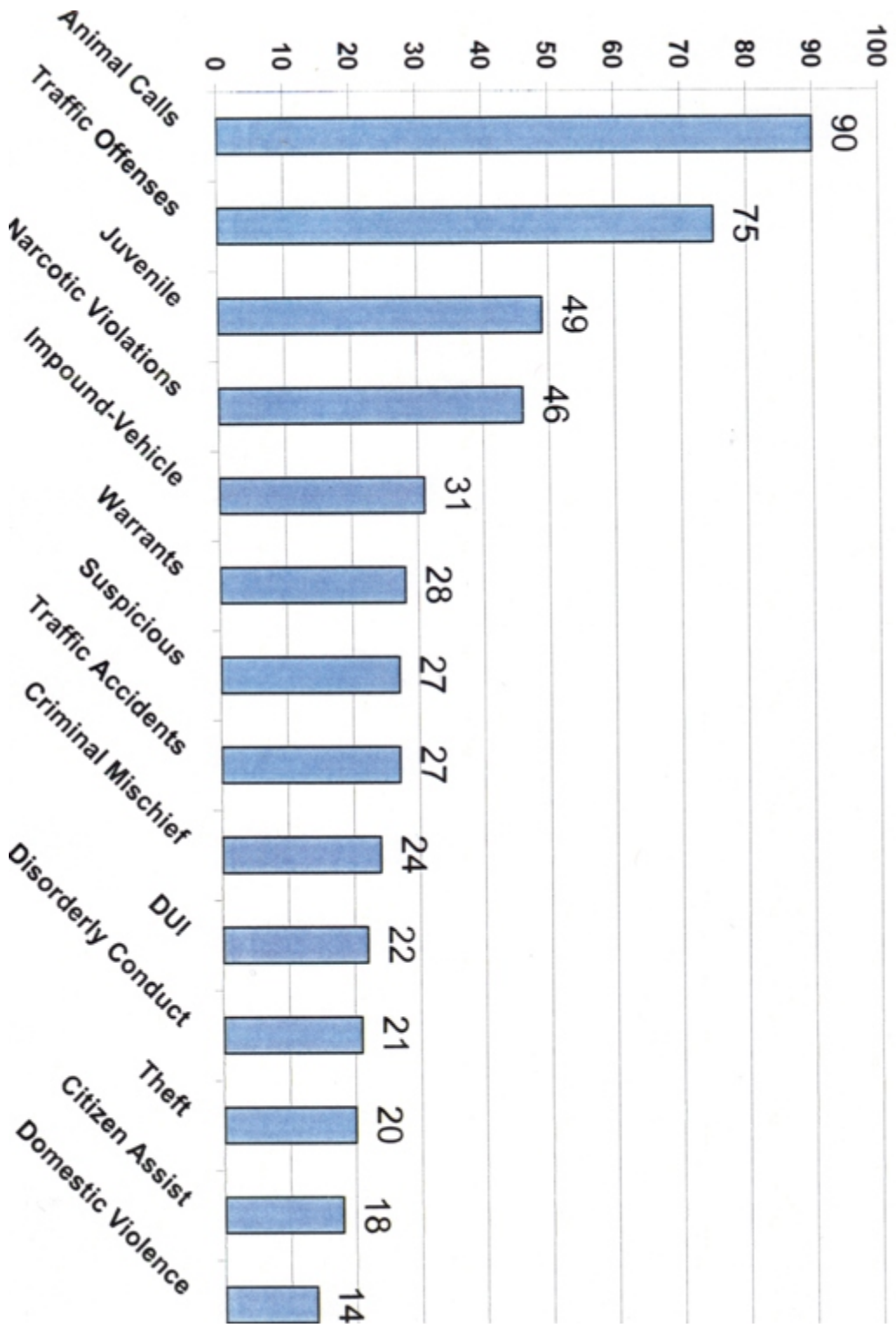
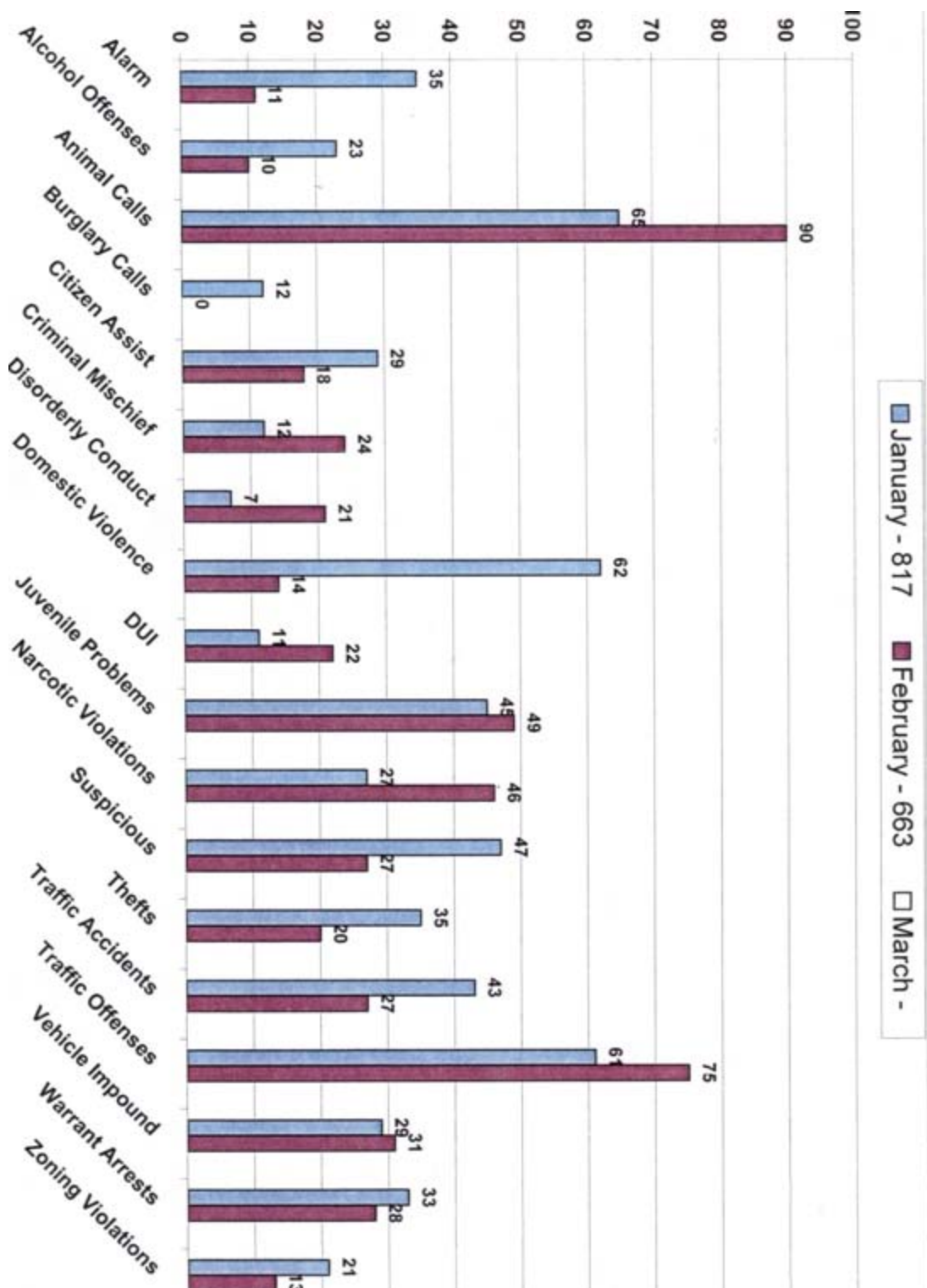


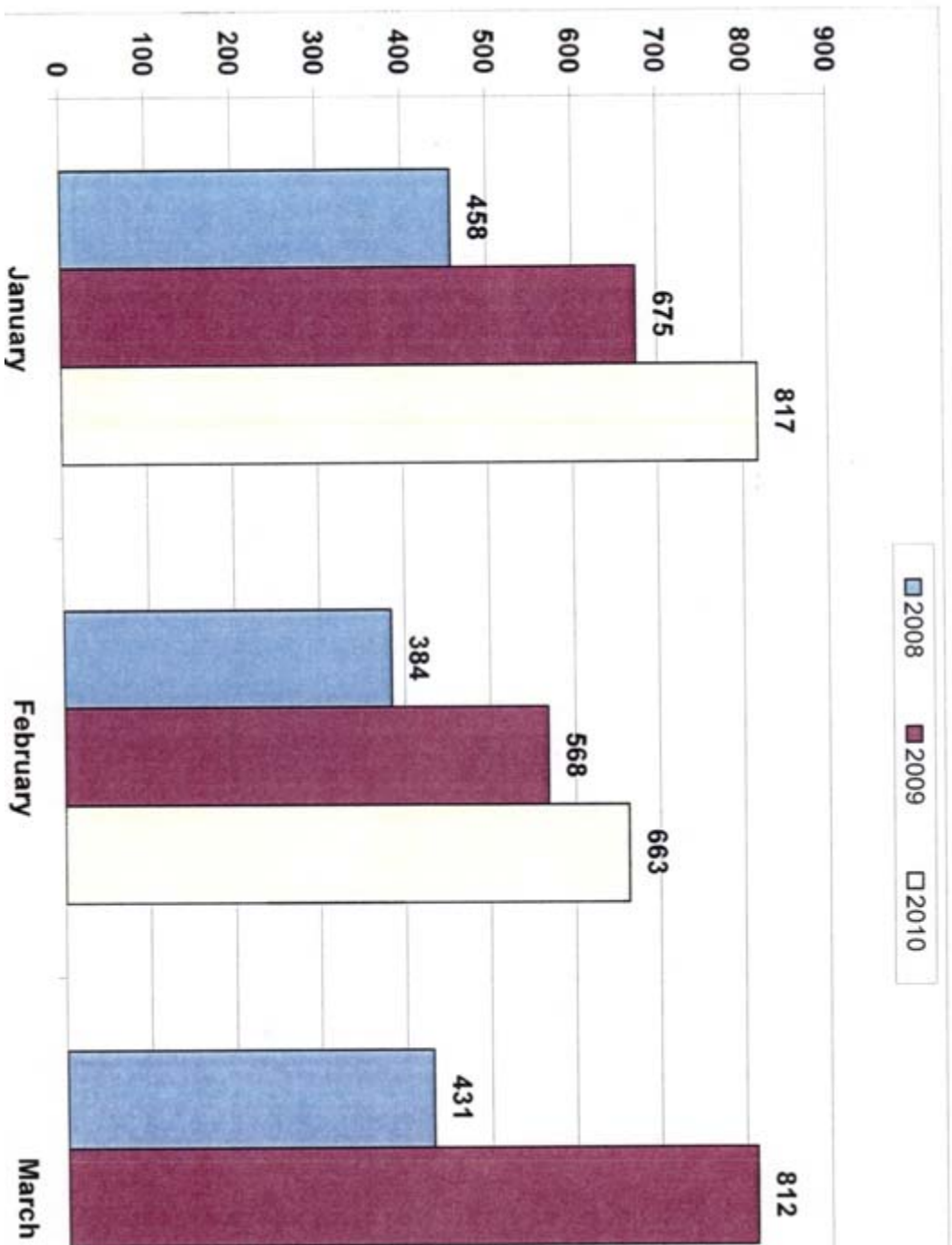

Investigations of Note

Two stalkers have been charged in separate cases. The first, a domestic violence-type stalker continued to shadow his estranged wife, with the second, classified as an acquaintance-type stalker, escalating his behavior since last summer. A third stalking investigation (love/obsession-type) remains active.

Juvenile-on-juvenile sex offenses are being investigated, with the suspect related to an adult sex offender arrested by the Saratoga Springs Police Department in 2008.

A woman reported her purse stolen, which was later recovered with all the contents intact except her prescription medications. Further investigation suggested the woman created a false police report to obtain additional prescriptions to provide for her probable prescription drug addiction. The woman was charged for making the false report.

A male suspect, arrested in the execution of a search warrant by the Special Response Team (SRT), elected to proceed with a Preliminary Hearing. After a presentation of the investigation and evidence, the suspect was bound over for trial for possession of a stolen handgun, methamphetamine, and possession of a firearm by a restricted person. The suspect has since relocated to another city.

A coordination meeting was held with representatives from Sage Hills, Saratoga Shores, and Harvest Elementary Schools to coordinate the radKids program (funding, equipment, program delivery, etc.).
