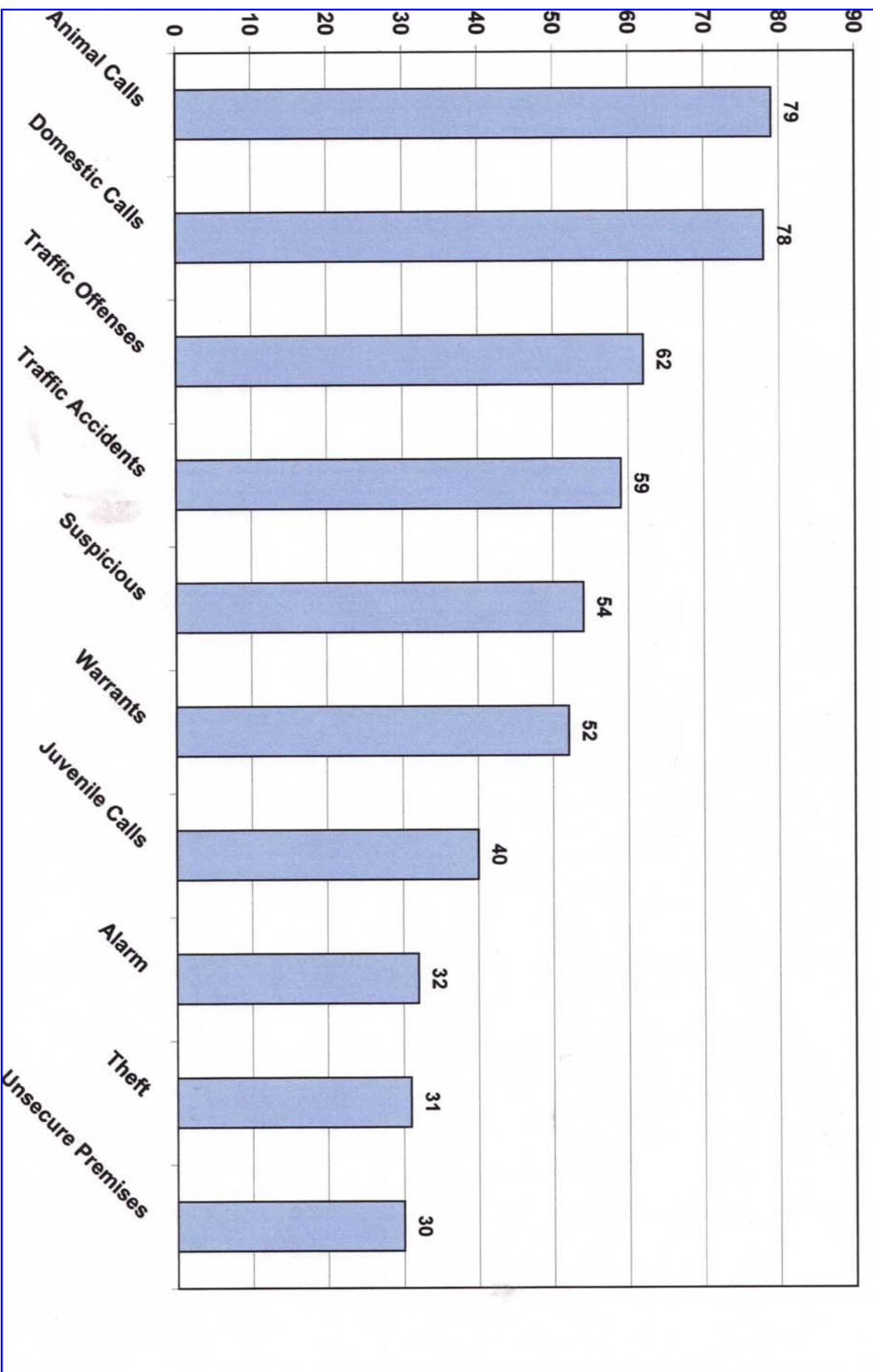
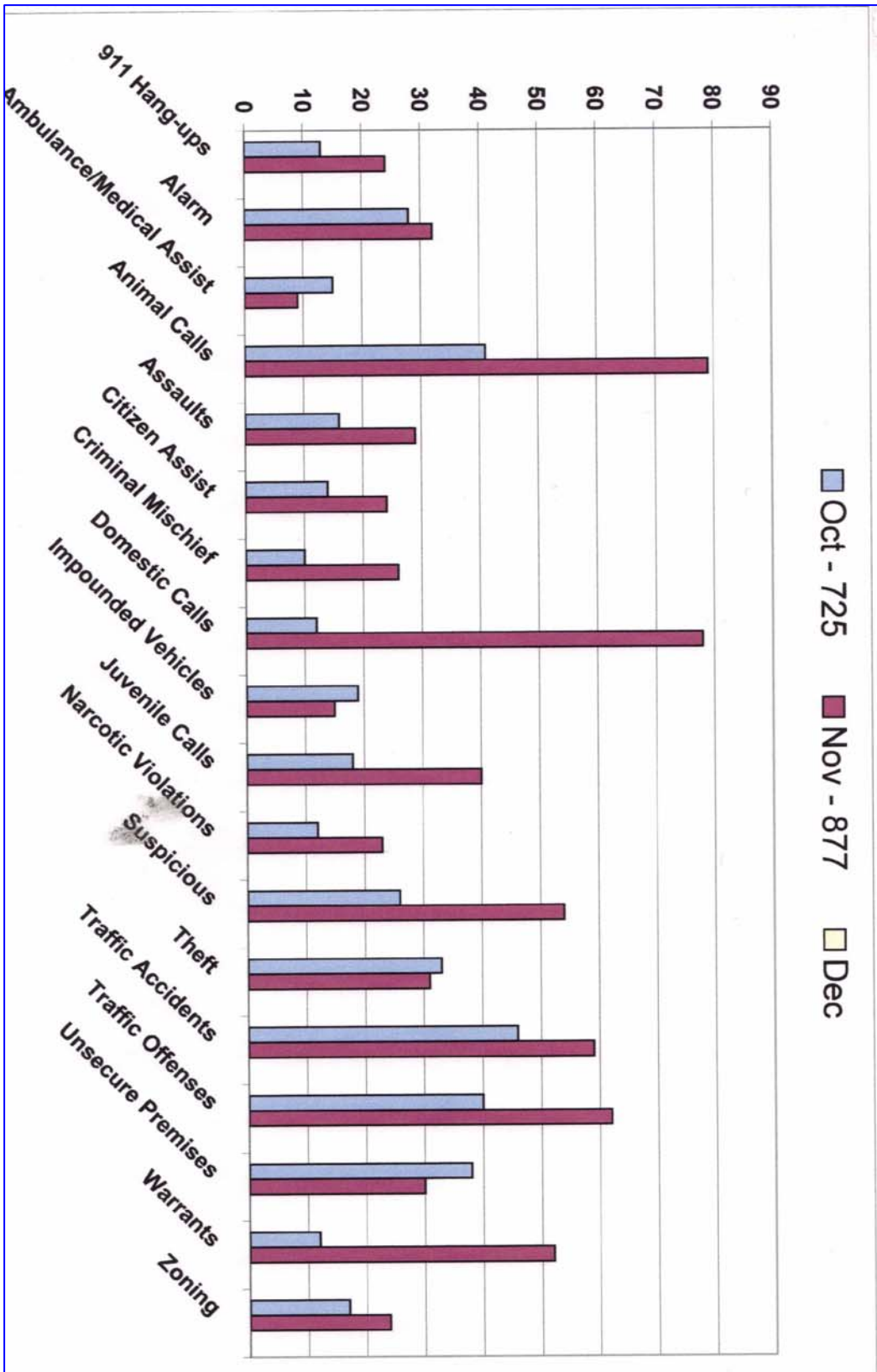


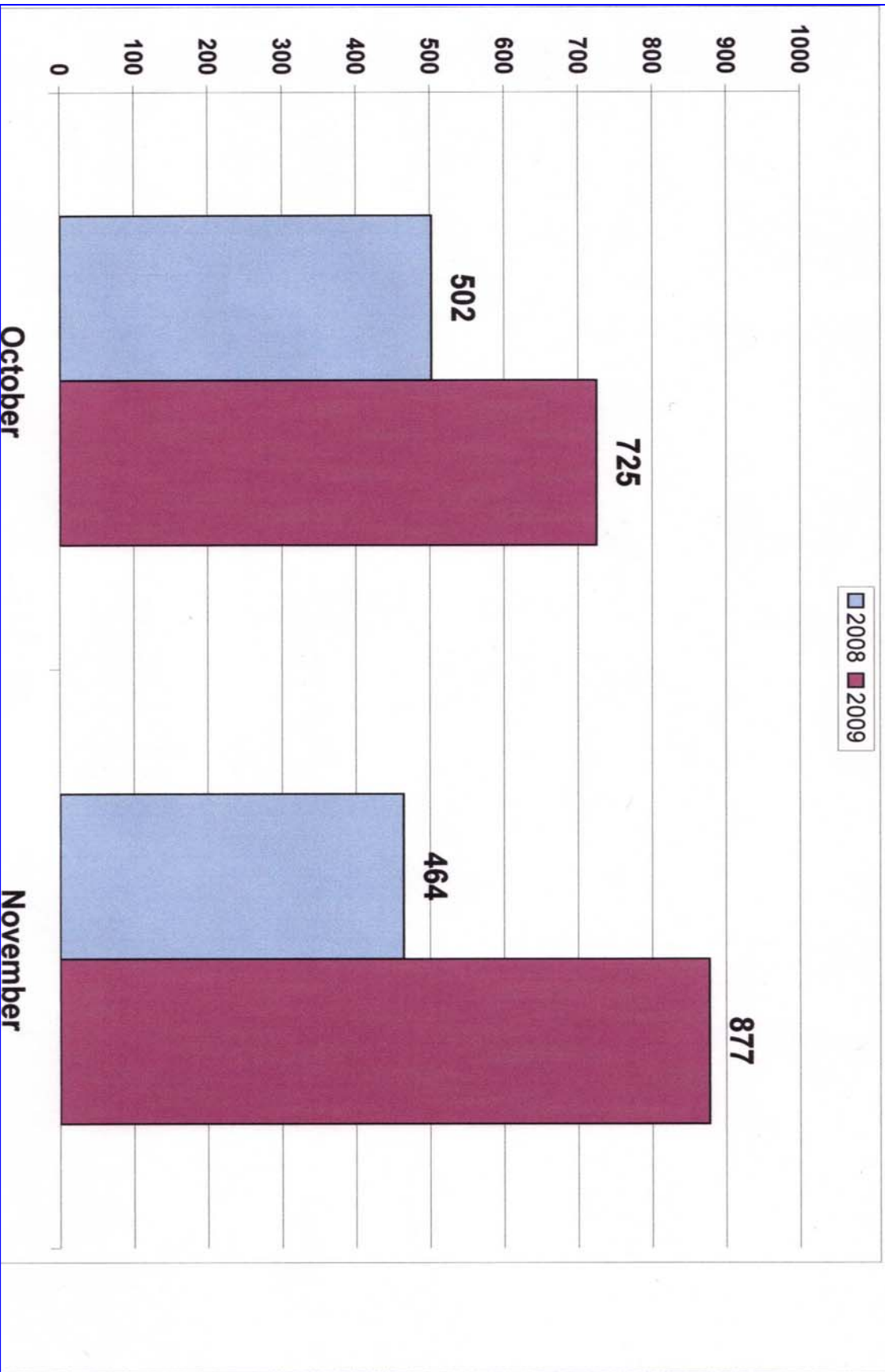

## **INVESTIGATIONS DIVISION MONTHLY SUMMARY**

November 1-30, 2009

### **Investigations of Note**

On approximately 11-16-09, the suspect became involved in a domestic violence incident with his wife in another state after the couple moved to that area from Eagle Mountain, UT approximately five days earlier (job transfer). During the incident, the suspect pointed a sawed-off shotgun at his wife and/or her children. The suspect was arrested and booked into jail, with the wife providing a short summary of suspect's recent criminal activity to county sheriff inspectors. The inspector then advised the Saratoga Springs Police Department, interviewed the wife, and attempted to interview the suspect (who declined to be interviewed). It appears the suspect is responsible for thefts, burglaries, and damage throughout the state, with probably in excess of \$20,000 in losses and damages in Saratoga Springs (this could include as many as 17 separate cases). Saratoga Springs Police divers expect to recover some items of evidence from the Jordan River in the near future.

Upon the recovery in West Valley of a motorcycle stolen in 2008, suspects (who were not present during the recovery) were identified through intelligence research. A confession was obtained from the driver of the crew and charges were screened against the other thieves (NOTE: this was a crew operating in Saratoga Springs with an M.O. of stealing anything of value left unattended in front yards or open garages and fencing the items in Salt Lake County).

The Victim Services Unit is now comprised of three advocates. Officer Davila was selected as an additional Uniformed Investigator for this shift deployment.
