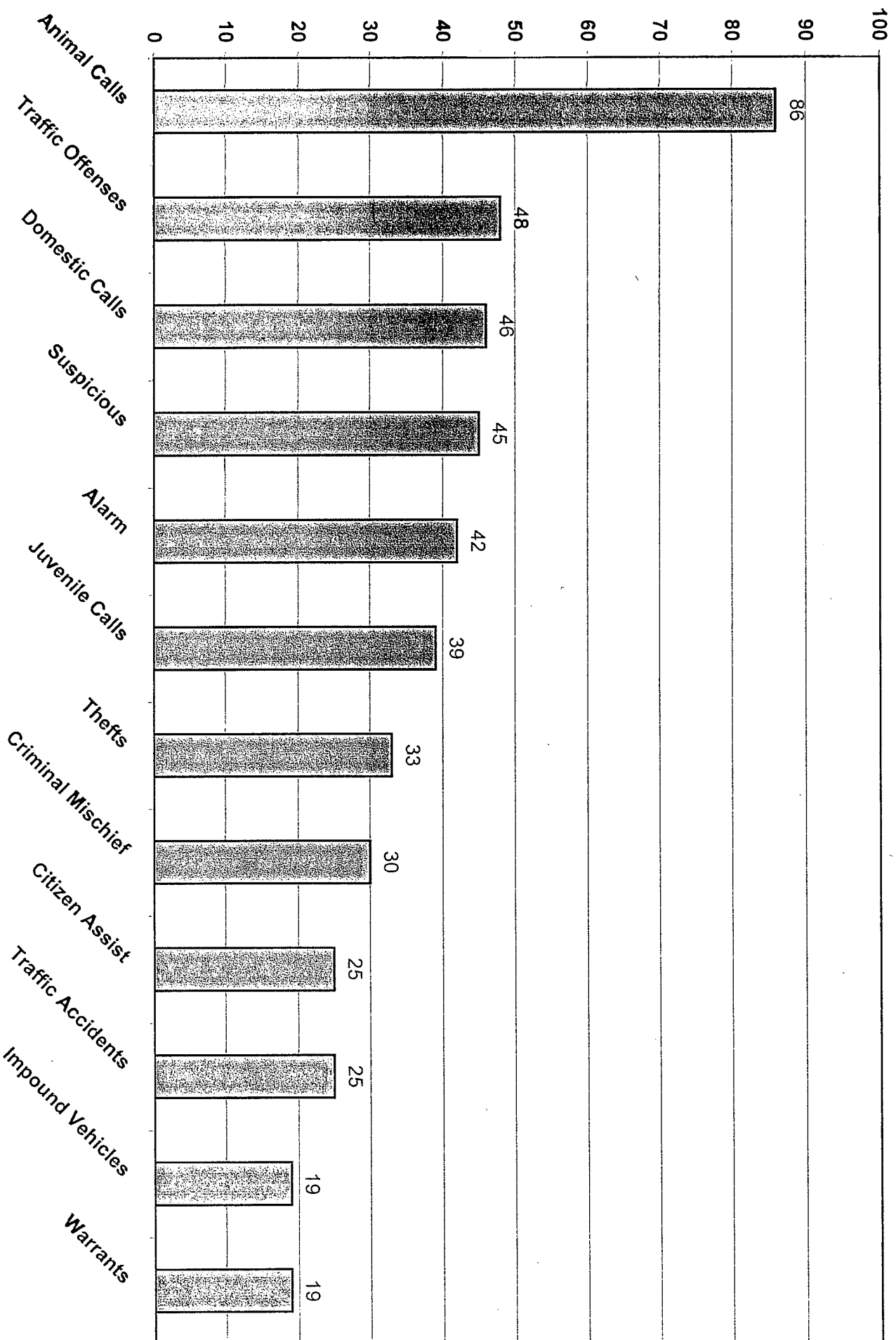
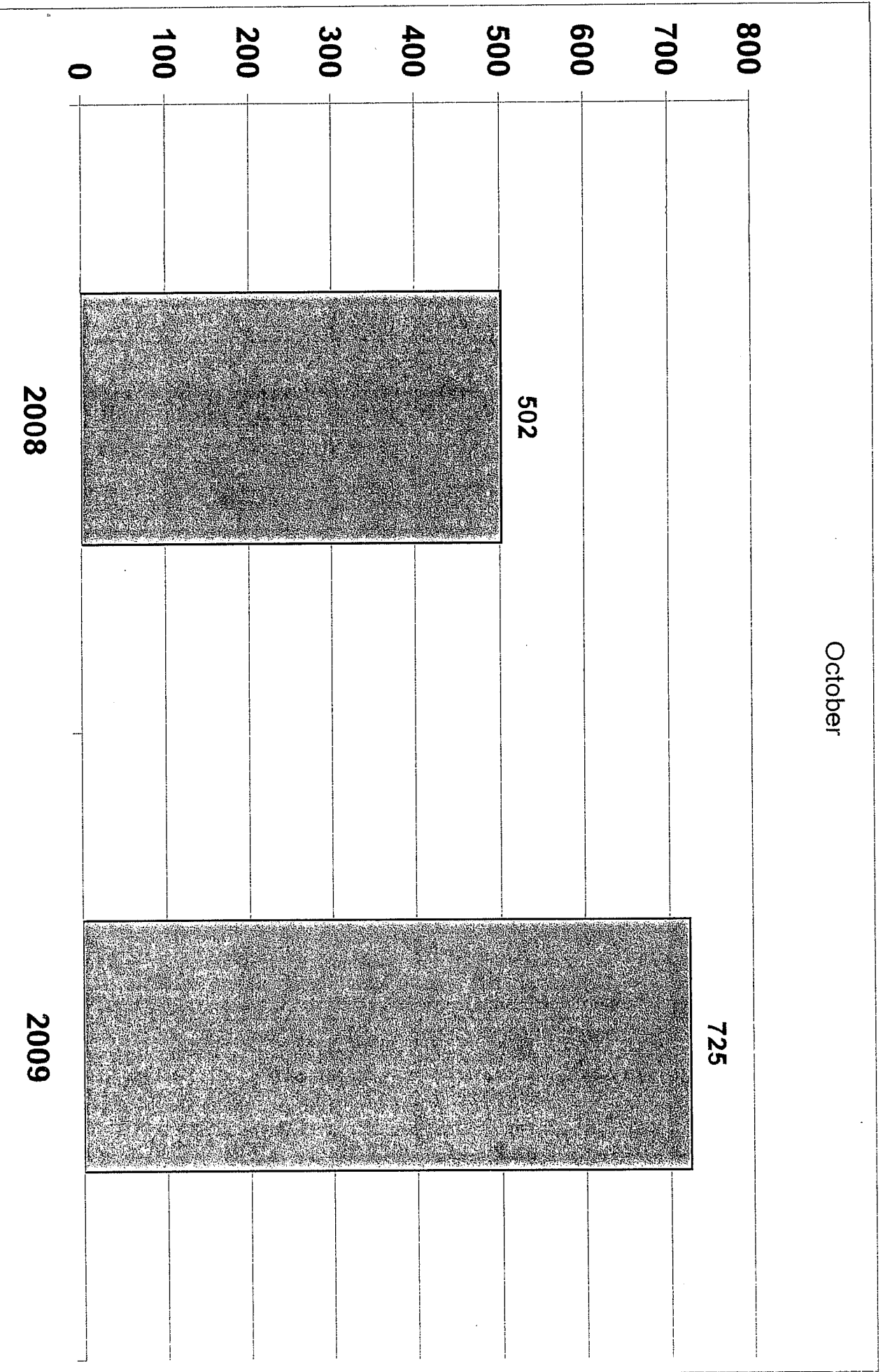

## **INVESTIGATIONS DIVISION MONTHLY SUMMARY**

**October 1-31, 2009**

### **Investigations of Note**

An investigative subpoena (telephone) was authored to identify a potential suspect in the Epic Bike theft. The suspect was tentatively identified, but has no stable residence, and is difficult to locate. Charges for theft were screened against the suspect.

Upon the recovery in West Valley of a motorcycle stolen in 2008, suspects (who were not present during the recovery) were identified through intelligence research. A confession was obtained from the driver of the crew and charges were screened against the other thieves (NOTE: this was a crew operating in Saratoga Springs with an M.O. of stealing anything of value left unattended in front yards or open garages and fencing the items in Salt Lake County).

A known suspect, and resident, sold multiple debt portfolios to multiple victims. The portfolios were demonstration documents which the suspect had no title to sell. The case was packaged and forwarded to the Attorney General's office for prosecution.

An additional volunteer has been screened and is currently being trained for service in the Victim Services Unit (This brings the total number of volunteers to two, with an additional applicant pending). Officer Davila was selected as an additional Uniformed Investigator for this shift deployment.
