**ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT SUMMIT MINUTES**

- 2) What specific activities or methods should the City undertake to promote economic development both employment and retail growth? Please include land use, zoning or other development-related issues.
- 3) What advice do you have for the City to maintain and enhance a positive image in the regional development community?

Each group was given an hour to discuss and present feedback from the questions. Then each group reconvened and discussed the ideas that were proposed.

Lehi Area Chamber of Commerce president, Donna Milakovic gave a presentation on the importance of the area chamber and the role it has on the City of Saratoga Springs.

The group then adjourned for lunch which was provided by Rubio's.
