CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

Mayor Pro-tempore Bud Poduska conducted the beginning of the meeting he then turned the time over to Fire Chief, Tim Hay.

Mayor Love arrived at this time. (4:35 p.m.)

1. Report from the Fire Department regarding long-range and other fire department matters.

Chief Hay discussed the status of a future station within the next 15 years and a second ambulance at the estimated cost of \$40,000 per year for six years. The Chief also indicated that the estimated cost for Paramedic services would be approximately \$168,000 and this would include training for the staff and an additional part-time staff position. Mayor and Council had asked brief question regarding the budget outline.

Chief Hay addressed the proposed budget for 2012-2013 which included adding three additional paid personnel, applying for the SAFER grant, purchasing a aerial which would includes an apparatus and equipment at the estimated cost of \$800,000. There would be a bond that would be paid out at 105,000 for ten years.

Chief Hay then proposed the budget outlook for the 2014-2015 which would include the replacement of the 2005 Engine at a cost estimate of \$500,000. The Chief outlined the 2015-2019 budgets which include the purchase of SCBA, a brush truck, the completion of third fire station and replacing the 2010 ambulance. The Chief briefly touched on the 2020-2025 budgets which include nine additional positions, an additional fire station, a fire truck for the third station, call volume increase, a necessity for a Fire Marshall and training officer.

Tim Hay reviewed with the Mayor and Council the projected budget costs for the upcoming five years.

Motion to adjourn at 5:18 p.m. was unanimous.
