- **Call to Order by Mayor Love.**

Item #1 Public Safety Reports from Fire Chief Tim Hay and Police Chief Gary Hicken.

Dawnya DeKarver, Saratoga Springs Fire Captain, presented to the Council the Fire/EMS monthly report for May.

Police Chief Gary Hicken presented to the Council the monthly statistics for May.

Item #2 Lease Agreement for the purchase of Police Vehicle.

Chris Pavia presented the lease agreement for the purchase of the Bluffdale Police Departments vehicles.

Motion was made by Councilman Poduska and seconded by Councilman Call to approve the Lease Agreement with Zions Bank for the purchase of Police vehicles. Those voting yes: Councilman Poduska, Councilman Call, Councilman McOmber, Councilman Miller and Councilman Tuley. The vote passed unanimous.

Item #3 Discussion and review of the City's ordinances, resolutions and processes related to dog at large violations.

Councilman Tuley reviewed with the City Council a tape of the minutes from July 14, 2009 Council meeting. He touched on the resolution that was adopted in July 2009. Councilman Tuley indicated that his understanding with adopting the resolution was that the Class B Misdemeanor would be eliminated. He then opened this item up for discussion.

Ken Leetham discussed the process of ACE court. He also stated that his understanding was that a Class B Misdemeanor is still a part of the ACE court schedule; that is , that it is not a criminal violation. Since the implementation of the ACE court, the City has not issued a criminal dog at large citation.

Mayor Love discussed the ACE court process and her understanding of the ordinance.

The Council discussed the intent and operations of the court system.

The Council agreed to have the City Attorney review this ordinance.

Item #4 Discussion of Tentative Budget for Fiscal Year 2010-2011.

The Mayor and Council discussed the proposed budget. The discussion also included stipends and reimbursements for the Mayor and Council.

Item #5 Resolution No. 10-20 (6-15-10): A resolution adopting the City of Saratoga Springs Municipal budget for Fiscal Year 2010-2011.

The Council did not approve Resolution R10-20. The resolution will be placed on June 22, 2010 City Council agenda for approval.

Motion to adjourn at 9:05 p.m. was unanimous.
