SPRING YOUTH SOCCER

Registration for youth soccer (ages 3-14) are taking place at the City offices until March 12. The City offices will be open on Saturday, March 12th from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. After March 12th there is a \$5 late fee assessed and no registrations will be taken after March 19th. UTILITY DROP BOXES

There is a utility payment box located in the parking lot of the new City offices for your convenience. The box is found in the northern landscaping island and may be easily accessed from your car.
