CHANGE IN GARBAGE PICKUP DAY

Just a reminder that weekly garbage pickup day has been changed from Friday to Thursday. Recycled pickup will remain on Fridays. On weeks where a public holiday occurs on or before the Thursday pickup, the pickup day will be moved to Friday. As usual, please make sure that your cans are out by 7:00 AM as some pickup times that you may be accustomed to will change during the day. CONSTRUCTION ON S.R. 73

The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) will be commencing a resurfacing project on State Route 73 (Lehi Main Street) from Redwood Road to 850 East in Lehi. A firm date for the project has not been scheduled, but it is believed that the work will start during the first two weeks in July and will run for approximately 35 days. Also, UDOT indicates that while most of the work will be done at night, drivers should expect delays at any time.

2005 MUNICIPAL ELECTION

In November 2005 the City will be holding a municipal election. The Mayor and two four-year term council seats are up this year. Interested candidates should be aware of the requirements to hold elected office and the dates in which to declare their candidacy. Candidates must meet the following requirements in order for their candidacy to be accepted: 1) must be a citizen of the United States, 2) must be at least 18 years old by the next election, 3) must be a registered voter within the City of Saratoga Springs, and 4) must have resided in the City of Saratoga Springs or recently annexed area for a period of 12 consecutive months immediately before the date to the election. Each person seeking to become a candidate for a municipal office must file a declaration of candidacy in person with the City Recorder during regular business hours (M-F 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.) between July 15, 2005 and no later than 5:00 p.m. on August 15, 2005. Interested persons must meet the qualifications and requirements set forth above in order for their declaration of candidacy to be accepted.

FALL SPORTS LEAGUES

Youth Soccer

Registration: July 5th through July 16th - Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Saturdays (July 9th and July 16th) from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. The City will not accept sign-ups after July 22nd. The season runs from August 20th through September 24th on Saturdays at Snow Springs Elementary. Ages 3-14 (children must turn 3 by August 20th). Cost is \$25.00. Late registration is \$30.00. If a shirt is needed, add an extra \$8.00.

Women's Soccer

Registration: July 5th through July 22nd - Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Saturdays (July 9th and July 16th) from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. No late registration is allowed. The season runs from August 20th through September 24th. Games will be played at Inlet Park. Ages 16 to adult. Cost is \$250.00 per team. 25 player maximum per team. Additional cost for shirt, if needed.

Flag Football

Registration: July 5th through July 29th - Monday through Fridays from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Late registration runs from August 1st through August 5th. The season runs from September 8th through October 13th. Games will be played on Thursdays at the Sunrise Meadows City Park. Ages 6 to 14. Cost is \$25.00. Late registration \$30.00. If a shirt if needed, add an extra \$8.00.
