2005 UNOFFICIAL PRIMARY ELECTION RESULTS

The City of Saratoga Springs held a Primary Election on Tuesday, October 4, 2005. We had 609 total votes cast with 3274 total registered voters, which was a 19% voter turnout. The following candidates will be on the ballot for the November General Election:

SECONDARY WATER SHUT-OFF

The City's secondary water system (outside irrigation) will be turned off on October 13, 2005 and will remain off until April 15, 2006. Each year the City closes the system at this time. One of the City's principal water sources for outside watering is the Utah Lake Distributing Canal. This canal always shuts down on or before October 15th each year. UTILITY RATE INCREASES

In last month's newsletter we informed you of the utility rate increases that the City Council adopted in August. You will notice that those utility rate increases are reflected in this month's utility bill. The new culinary water rates are \$8.75 per month and \$0.95 per 1,000 gallons used. The new sewer rates are \$9.50 per month and \$1.40 per 1,000 gallons of water used. The new garbage rates are \$10.70 per month for the first can and \$6.15 per month for the second can. The secondary water rate also increased by 4%, but will affect all residents differently depending upon the size of their lot. If you would like to know what the rate is for you and you know the size of your property, you can view a table that contains the new rates by logging onto the City's website and clicking on utility rates from the home page.
