### **SARATOGA SPRINGS GETS NEW ZIP CODE**

Move over **90210**. The newest hot zip code is **84045**. The United States Postal Service has announced beginning July 1, 2006 Saratoga Springs will have its own zip code. The post office suggests you notify people with whom you correspond as soon as possible so you can start using the new zip code on the effective date.

The post office will still ensure delivery of your mail with the old zip code for a period of one year.

### **2006 REPUBLICAN PRIMARY ELECTION**

The Republican party primary will be held June 27, 2006. There are two county offices in the primary-Commission Seat A- Jerry Grover(i) vs Gary Anderson; County Clerk- Bryson Thompson vs Cary McConnell; and US House of Representatives (Congressman)- Chris Cannon (i) vs John Jacob.

You must be a registered Republican to vote in the Republican primary. You can register as a Republican (affiliate) at the poll. You may NOT register to vote at the polls.

If you are not registered to vote in Saratoga Springs, there will be satellite voter registration on June 9<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> at the Saratoga Springs City Hall. This is the only way to register if you are not already registered to vote in order to vote in the June 27<sup>th</sup> primary.

There will be early voting from June 12<sup>th</sup> through the 23<sup>rd</sup> in the Utah County Offices located at 100 East Center Street in Provo

### **MOSQUITO SEASON**

Mosquito season is upon us again. The CDC has some easy, sensible advice all of us can do to prevent mosquito bites. The peak biting time for mosquitoes is dusk to dawn. Avoid being outdoors during those hours if you can. If you are outdoors in the evening wear long-sleeved shirts and long pants if weather permits. Use an insect repellent with at least 7% DEET. Apply to exposed skin and to clothing.

Eliminate mosquito breeding sites:

Dispose of water-holding containers.

Eliminate discarded tires.

Clean roof gutters.

Turn plastic wading pools upside down.
