CITY ANNOUNCES INTENTION TO CREATE POLICE DEPARTMENT

As many of you may already be aware, the City Council announced their intention to create a Saratoga Springs Police Department. It is anticipated that this new department would begin operations on July 1, 2007. The City is currently accepting applications for Police Chief (more information on this position can be found at www.saratoga-springs.net). The City plans on hiring 12 officers between January and June 2007. We hope there will be much interest from our residents and encourage you to refer to the City's website next year where position openings will be posted.

EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES WITH THE CITY

Receptionist (part-time)

This position is responsible for answering and referring all incoming calls on the City's general telephone lines, for greeting visitors to the City's main offices, providing them with general information and directions, taking payments, setting up utility accounts and for performing routine office support functions. Salary: \$10-11/hr. Work Hours: 12pm to 5pm M-F until Jan. 2007. Starting Jan. 2007 hours are 8am to 12pm M-F.

Building Inspector III

This position will be a staff position under the direction of the Chief Building Official and will be responsible for residential and commercial building inspections throughout the City. Applicant must have current ICC certifications in Commercial Building, Electrical, Plumbing and Mechanical inspections and be licensed with the State of Utah. The salary range for an Inspector III is \$21.25-\$29.62 per hr DOQ. This position may be filled with an Inspector II.
