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### **UTAH FOOD BANK DONATIONS**

### **KEEP PIPES SAFE FROM FREEZING**

During extreme cold nighttime temperatures you can do a few simple things to keep your water pipes from freezing. Leave the nighttime thermostat at 60 degrees or higher. Leaving the water running just a trickle from 1 faucet will also help prevent frozen pipes.

As a reminder, please try to have any cars parked off the streets and cans removed quickly during the winter months. ### **SCHOOL CROSSWALK SAFETY**

Here are a few reminders from our crossing guards. Please review them with your children. All drivers must stop when the crossing guard has the sign raised. Children should remain on the sidewalk and cross only after the crossing guard signals for them to cross. Children should only cross at designated crosswalks. Some are crossing away from the crosswalks so they don't have to wait for a crossing guard to assist them. Children on bicycles or scooters need to ride in appropriate places and not weave in and out of traffic. They need to cross at the crosswalks just as pedestrians do. They need to walk the bicycles or scooters across the street after being directed by the crossing guard.
