2007 MUNICIPAL ELECTION

In November 2007 the City will be holding a municipal election. Three four-year term council seats are up this year. Interested candidates should be aware of the requirements to hold elected office and the dates in which to declare their candidacy. Candidates must meet the following requirements in order for their candidacy to be accepted: 1) must be a citizen of the United States, 2) must be at least 18 years old by the next election, 3) must be a registered voter within the City of Saratoga Springs, and 4) must have resided in the City of Saratoga Springs or recently annexed area for a period of 12 consecutive months immediately before the date to the election. Each person seeking to become a candidate for a municipal office must file a declaration of candidacy in person with the City Recorder during regular business hours (M-F 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.) between July 1, 2007 and no later than 5:00 p.m. on July 15, 2007.

If you have recently moved in, you will need to register or re-register to vote in Saratoga Springs. You may obtain a voter registration form at the City Offices, in the Qwest phone book, or online at www.co.utah.ut.us. If you have any questions about if you are registered to vote or not, you may go online at www.co.utah.ut.us or contact the Utah County Clerk at 851-8128.
