FALL YOUTH SOCCER

Fall soccer registration will be July 2nd through July 20th. Late registration is July 23rd through July 27th. Register at the City offices Monday - Friday 8 am to 5 pm. Ages: 3 through 7th grade, co-ed teams. Must be 3 years old before the first game. All pre-school aged children will be together. The fee is \$27.00 during regular registration and \$32.00 for late registration. Shirts are \$8.00 and may be used year after year. The season is August 18th through October 6th with games on Saturdays except for Labor Day weekend when the game will be during the week. 2007 MUNICIPAL ELECTION

In November 2007 the City will be holding a municipal election. Three four-year term council seats are up this year. Interested candidates should be aware of the requirements to hold elected office and the dates in which to declare their candidacy. Candidates must meet the following requirements in order for their candidacy to be accepted: 1) must be a citizen of the United States, 2) must be at least 18 years old by the next election, 3) must be a registered voter within the City of Saratoga Springs, and 4) must have resided in the City of Saratoga Springs or recently annexed area for a period of 12 consecutive months immediately before the date to the election. Each person seeking to become a candidate for a municipal office must file a declaration of candidacy in person with the City Recorder during regular business hours (M-F 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.) between July 1, 2007 and no later than 5:00 p.m. on July 15, 2007.

If you have recently moved in, you will need to register or re-register to vote in Saratoga Springs. You may obtain a voter registration form at the City Offices, in the Qwest phone book, or online at www.co.utah.ut.us. FIREWORKS REMINDER

With the up coming holidays the Saratoga Springs Fire Department would like to remind people of the dangers of fireworks. This year, more so than others, the potential for starting a wildfire is greater. With several days in the 90 and 100 the grasses and shrubs are dangerously dry.

Things that we can do to avoid a problem include setting off fireworks in a safe and developed area with a fire extinguisher or hose nearby. Do not allow children to use fireworks without the supervision of an adult. Please check your local and County rules that apply to types of fire works and their restrictions. The City of Saratoga Springs has banned fireworks in all of the undeveloped area of the City.
