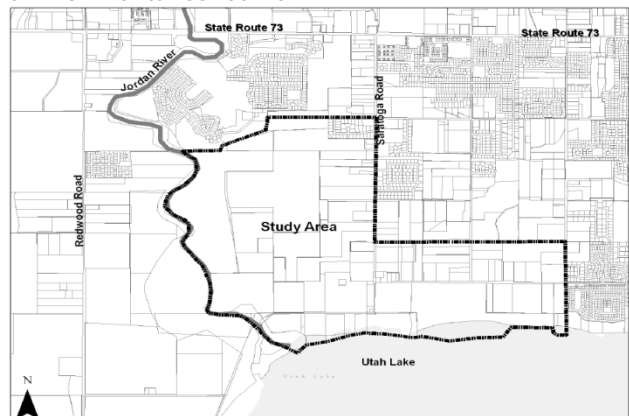
## BECOME INVOLVED IN THE PUBLIC PLANNING PROCESS!

You are invited to a public meeting on October 18, 2007, from 6:00-8:00 p.m. at the City offices located at 1307 N. Commerce Drive, Suite 200 (behind Smith's).

October is National Community Planning month and the City would like you to meet the new Planning Director and the planning staff, ask questions about development throughout the City, and allow you to provide input on an upcoming Small Area Plan for Saratoga's North Shore.

The City has commissioned an energetic team of senior level students from the Urban Planning program at the University of Utah to design a Small Area Plan for Saratoga's North Shore. They would like the public to provide input and help develop solutions for this area. The North Shore project area is bounded by the Jordan River on the west, the City's Annexation Boundary on the North, Loch Lomond Subdivision on the East and Utah Lake on the South as seen on the map below.

The City of Saratoga Springs is updating the area's current land use map which designates this area for Rural Residential development and is considering what other types of development may be more suitable for the community's vision and goals. Issues that will be discussed include: future land use and potential zoning, development possibilities, transportation corridors, potential annexations, and environmental concerns.

**HALLOWEEN SAFETY TIPS**

Kids love Halloween, and with the excitement of it we sometimes forget simple rules to keeping our children safe. Below are some common sense tips to help you and your child have a fun, safe, and memorable Halloween experience.

- If your kids are trick-or-treating, know the route they will be taking if you aren't going with them and set a time when they should be home.
- Help your child pick out or make a costume that will be safe. A costume should be fire proof and the eye holes should be large enough for good peripheral vision.
- If you set jack-o-lanterns on your porch with candles in them, make sure that they are far enough out of the way so that kid's costumes won't accidentally be set on fire.
- Feeding your kids before trick-or treating will make them less likely to eat the candy they collect before you have a chance to check it.
- Teach your kids basic everyday safety such as not getting into strangers cars, or checking both ways before crossing the street. This will help make them safer when they are out trick-or-treating.

It's that time of year again! Those residents with Pressurized Irrigation please leave your individual shut-off valves in the "open" position to allow for proper drainage of the system. The City will be winterizing the system around October 15<sup>th</sup>. After that date, the system will be deactivated until spring. Each irrigation system must be completely drained to prevent damage to the system components caused by water freezing inside the pipes, sprinklers, and valves.
