The City of Saratoga Springs to Hold Fundraiser for Victims of Recent Flood

On the evening of September 1, 2012, a heavy rain and hail storm hit the City of Saratoga Springs, triggering a mud slide that impacted twelve homes in our city, leaving these homeowners with substantial damage and cleanup to manage. Local residents and surrounding cities engaged immediately to assist these homeowners to recover and clean what they could but these homes still require repair, and the financial impact to these homeowners is significant.

In an effort to help diffuse some of these repair costs, local resident Kara Martin and the City of Saratoga Springs Civic Events team are hosting a fundraiser, tonight, September 17, 2012 at Neptune Park (452 W 400 N, Saratoga Springs) from 6:30 – 9:30pm. Local musicians Kenny Favero, Stephanie Mabey and the band, After the Storm, will provide the entertainment and there will be food, a bake sale, silent auction and many other ways to participate and donate to this great cause.

Mayor Love commented; “Our city has had its share of challenges this year with our fire in June and this recent flood. In every case our residents engaged immediately, providing physical, emotional and financial help to their neighbors without a second thought. My gratitude goes out to all of you for proving that we are stronger when we work together and the best solutions are found at the most local level.
