## SPRING CLEAN-UP DUMPSTERS

Dates: May 6 – May 15

The City has consolidated the dumpster locations for spring cleanup this year. The new location is at the City's Public Works site located on Saratoga Road at 900 East. This will be the only dumpster location in the City.

We are only offering one location to ensure that dumpsters are available for use. Previously, the dumpsters located throughout the City would fill quickly and not be available for use. Having multiple dumpsters at one location will ensure that each dumpster is hauled away and a new one is delivered as soon as possible for residents' use.

Just a reminder, this service is provided only for bagged household and/or green waste items. Furniture, electronics, oil/fuel, kitchen appliances, tires, rocks and concrete are not to be placed in these dumpsters.

## TIPS TO HELP SLOW THE FLOW

- With the warmer temperatures, landscapes still do not require much, if any water. Adjust the number of days you water each week depending on the season and weather. A helpful map is available online at [www.slowtheflow.org](http://www.slowtheflow.org) and click on the "Utah Weekly Lawn Watering Guide."
- Schedule a free water check for your sprinkler system between May and August by visiting [www.slowtheflow.org](http://www.slowtheflow.org) or calling 1-877-728-3420 to schedule an appointment. Water checks are free and help reduce water waste. The checks analyze the efficiency of your system providing a customized watering schedule based on soil type, grass root depth, sprinkler distribution and water pressure.
- Water smarter by installing rain and moisture sensors. The rain and moisture sensors help shut your sprinkler system off if there is rain and to measure the moisture level in the grass to reduce the amount of water used in regular watering. Once the sensors are triggered, the sprinkler system shuts off.
- Be selective in the plants you use for your landscape. Look for water-wise plants and/or plants that can thrive in our climate and soil types.
- Using mulch reduces evaporation from the soil and helps prevent weeds from growing in areas where water is needed for ornamental plants.
- Adjust your lawn mower to a higher setting. Longer grass shades root systems and holds soil moisture better. By raising your lawn mower height another ½ to 1 inch, you are promoting the conservation of water in grass.
- Sweep your driveways and sidewalks with a broom instead of spraying them off with a hose. It will save 80 gallons of water every time.

## POLL WORKERS NEEDED!

The Utah County Elections Office is recruiting poll workers to staff the polling locations for the 2016 Presidential Election. This is a unique opportunity for Utah County residents to both serve their community and have a hands-on experience with the election process.

The Presidential Primary Election will be held on June 28, 2016. Primary Early Voting will be held from June 14 to 24, 2016. The Presidential General Election will be held on November 8, 2016. General Early Voting will be held from October 25 to November 4, 2016. Help is needed County-wide. There is a stipend of \$150 for Poll Clerks. Early Voting Clerks receive \$10 per hour. Poll Managers will receive a stipend of \$225. Early Voting Poll Managers receive a stipend of \$12 per hour.

In addition, decomposing leaf and grass clippings can rob streams and lakes of oxygen.**
