

A. How do I get the necessary documentation for the Veterans

Monument? If you need it for you, do one of the following:

1. Go to MilConnect: <https://milconnect.dmdc.osd.mil/milconnect/>
  - a. If you have an account, log in and go to DPRIS: <https://milconnect.dmdc.osd.mil/milconnect/protected/portlet/dpris> and fill out the form to request documents from your OMPF.
  - b. If you do not have an account, you will need to create one first.
2. Mail or fax (314-801-9195) a Standard Form 180 to the National Personnel Records Center (NPRC). <https://www.archives.gov/files/sf180-request-pertaining-to-military-records-exp-april2018-1.pdf>
3. Write a letter to the NPRC.

B. If you need it for someone else and you are the next of kin (sibling, parent, child, spouse) of a Veteran who has passed away:

1. Mail or fax a Standard Form 180 to the National Personnel Records Center (NPRC). <https://www.archives.gov/files/sf180-request-pertaining-to-military-records-exp-april2018-1.pdf>
2. Write a letter to the NPRC.
