Saratoga Springs Continues City-Wide Planning Update

The City of Saratoga Springs hopes to connect with residents to encourage participation in the development of a new General Plan for the city.

The General Plan will serve as the City's guide for the future building of streets and pathways, developing commercial and residential land, and planning for economic development for the next 20 years. SECONDARY WATER TURN-OFF DATES AND INFORMATION

It's that time of year again. The City will be winterizing the pressurized irrigation system beginning the week of October 15. After that date, the system will be deactivated until spring. Residents with pressurized irrigation should leave individual shut-off valves in the "open" position to allow for proper drainage of the system. Each irrigation system must be completely drained to prevent damage to the system components caused by water freezing inside the pipes, sprinklers and valves. After November 1, please close the individual shut-off ball valve to the "off" position in preparation for spring. Small Temporary Signs

Purple is the symbolic color for domestic violence awareness and represents the fight against domestic violence. The purpose of wearing purple ribbons throughout the month of October is to get people talking about domestic violence and to let victims know they are not alone and that resources are available to them. In the library this month we will be displaying the Clothesline Project. This is a powerful display of t-shirts decorated by individual survivors of abuse. The Clothesline Project's purpose is to educate, document and raise society's awareness of the extent of the problem of violence against women.




